A summary of the National Park Boundary Review Project investigating possibilities for increasing the area of designated landscape between the Lake District and Yorkshire Dales National Parks

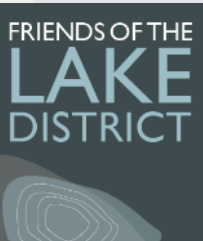
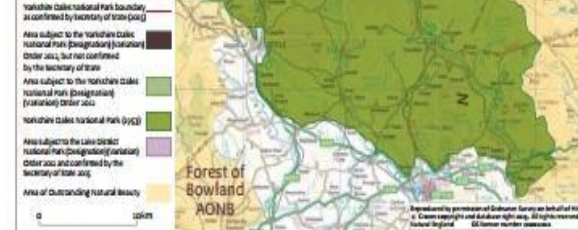
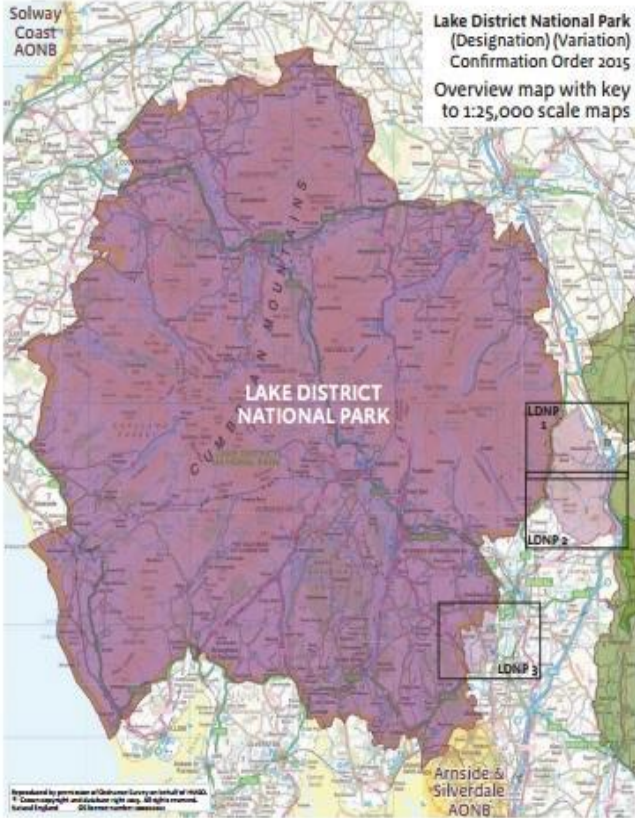

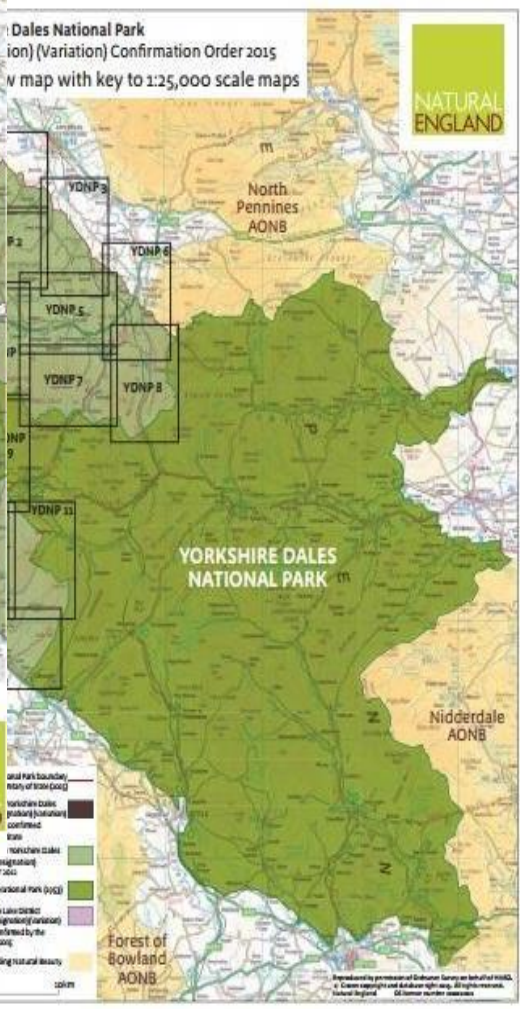

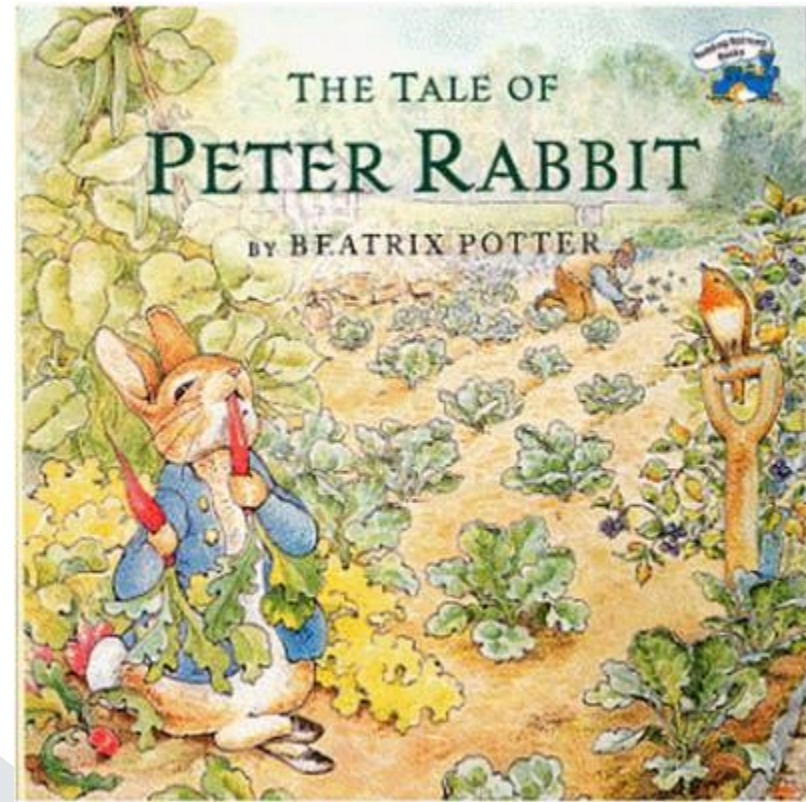
